

Woodland Presbyterian School Dress Code (Senior Kindergarten - 4th Grade)

Woodland's dress code philosophy is intended to reflect the school's mission and values as a Christian educational community by providing a standard that creates a positive disciplined environment. A dress code policy allows students and staff to concentrate on instruction rather than peer pressure and competition which may cause distractions in learning. Woodland administration has the final determination of dress code compliance and reserves the right to modify the dress code. Failure to comply may require the parent to provide a change of clothes.

Required Items	All uniforms must be purchased from Lands' End and must be on the school's approved list. Students in grades SK-4 must purchase the cobalt-colored polo shirt from Lands' End to wear on all off-campus field trips and other school-sponsored events. Clothing may not be distressed or frayed and must be free of any holes, stains, or messaging.
Shirts	Girls - Tops clearly designed to be worn outside the skirt or pants may be un-tucked; others must be tucked with a belt or waistband showing. Undergarments should not be visible below the un-tucked shirt. Boys - Shirts must be tucked, with belt or waistband showing. All Students - Shirts or tops may not have writing, with the exception of the school logo where required or permitted. All undershirts must be white. Writing on shirts must not be visible through the shirt.
Girls Skirts/Skorts/Jumpers	Length of skirts, skorts, and jumpers must be no shorter than 3 inches above the knee. Shorts of any kind worn under skirts or jumpers should not be visible when standing or walking.
Pants/Shorts	Belts must be worn with pants or shorts with belt loops and are to be worn securely around the waist.
Shoes	Athletic shoes, oxfords, and wallaby-type shoes are the only type of shoes allowed. Athletic shoes must be worn on P.E. days and are strongly encouraged as the preferred footwear. Shoes must be conservative in color. Shoes with wheels or lights are not allowed.
Socks/Tights	Girls - Tights may be footed or footless and may be worn in only solid black, navy, or white. All Students - Socks are mandatory and must be predominantly blue, black, or white.
Hair Accessories Miscellaneous	Boys - Hair must be neatly combed, out of the eyes, and off the collar. Boys may not wear earrings. Girls - All jewelry and headbands must be conservative. All Students - No novelty hair accessories are allowed. Multiple necklaces and bracelets are prohibited. Extreme types of haircuts and/or hair color are not allowed. Hair color must not deviate beyond the usual hair color range.
Jackets Sweatshirts Pullovers	The Lands' End sweatshirt with the official school logo and the designated uniform sweatshirts are the only approved uniform sweatshirts. Non-uniform outerwear (jackets, sweatshirts, etc.) may not be worn in the school building during the school day. Non-uniform clothing or accessories, including all outerwear, that advertises subjects inappropriate for school may not be worn. Jackets purchased from Lands' End with the Woodland logo may be worn in school.
Non-Uniform Days	Tops from the Woodland Spirit Shop or as part of a Woodland-sponsored event or Woodland athletic team can only be worn on Spirit Days. Jeans, jean shorts or skirts, khaki pants, or khaki shorts or skirts are acceptable these days. On Spirit Day, students may not wear gym shorts, P.E. uniforms, leggings, or pajama bottoms. Shorts and skirts must be dress-code length (3 inches above the knee) . If not participating in non-uniform days, students must be in school uniform.
