REGISTRATION

Please complete online registration, payment, and the non-refundable \$60 registration fee to attend **BLA&T** Day Camp. Registration fee is \$60 per family. Students who are only participating in specialty camps do not pay the registration fee. Enrollment is filled on a first-come, first-served basis. **Camps are closed one week prior to start date.**

If attending a "Specialty Camp" and need more care, sign up for a "half day" of BLA&T Day Camp along with the "Specialty Camp for 8 hours of daily care.

AGES

We invite students who are entering 2K (2 years old) through rising 8th Graders to join us for a summer of fun. All grades listed are based on Fall of 2021.

Registration: \$60 one time per family (non-refundable)
Daily Rate: \$50

Half-day Rate: \$25 (any 5 hours during the day)
Half-day Weekly Rate: \$125
Middle School Camp: \$195 weekly rate
Middle school daily rate: \$45

- **A late charge of \$2 per minute will be assessed to children remaining on campus after 6 p.m.**
- **Fees must be paid the end of the prior week. Drop-in campers pay the morning of drop-in.**
- **Campers attending specialty camps only do not pay registration fee.**
- **A \$35 fee will be charged if fees are not paid in advance.**
- **When applicable, include all campers specialty camps in each payment. All registrations must be made online.**

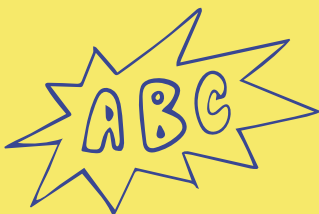

Campers should wear comfortable play clothes each day. TENNIS SHOES are highly recommended.

Safety

Your child's safety is our priority. All doors entering the facility are locked at all times. **BLA&T** campers do not leave the premises. Outside playtime is modified or restricted when a heat advisory is in effect.

Mask are required of all students and staff. Temperature checks will be conducted at drop off.

Specialty Camp Policies

Please complete the online registration with payment. Deposits are required on some camps and completion of payment is processed the Friday before the camp starts. If a specialty class is full or canceled due to lack of participation, you will be contacted via email and offered the opportunity to transfer to another specialty camp or receive a full refund. Fees may not be pro-rated and are non-refundable. All grade levels are based on 2021-2022 school year. Specialty camp teachers will contact you with drop-off and pickup instructions. Registration closes the Monday before camp begins.

Water Play Day

Every Wednesday, weather permitting, is water play day. Campers need waterproof sunscreen applied by the parent before camp, we will reapply as needed.

Shirts may be worn to protect against sun burn. Please send child in one piece swimsuit, swim shoes, towel and change of clothes.

Bike Day

Bikes, roller blade/scooter day on Thursday—bring to blacktop in back. **Helmets and pads are required.**

Outside Play

We do not play outside for very long when it is too hot or if there is an advisory for heat, (15-30 minutes in the morning). When we are outside, we keep the campers supplied with water, juice, popcicles, snow cones, ice.

Snack & Lunch

Camp provides 2 snack and one morning snack and an afternoon snack. No microwave or refrigerator is available for lunches.

Special Visitors

We will have many activities and visitors to entertain campers during the summer! Please check camp calendar. Please read your calendar to be prepared each day, although sometimes changes have to be made without time to notify you.

Technology

BLA&T DISCIPLINE POLICY

Campers are expected to follow all WPS rules. The administration reserves the right to dismiss, without refunds, any child whose behavior poses a discipline problem. The following behaviors may result in the dismissal of your child from **BLA&T** Summer Camp:

- **A child demonstrating behavior that is hazardous to the safety of other children**
- **A child requiring excessive one-on-one attention from the staff**
- **A child using inappropriate language**
- **A child being disrespectful to the staff or verbally abusive to other children.**

PAYMENT POLICY

The \$60 registration fee is non-refundable.

In the event you must cancel, you will receive a credit as defined below:

- **Credit will be credited to your Active account for future usage.**
- **Cancellations received within 48 hours of session start date forfeit full tuition.**
- **Cancellation requests due to illness, or accident or personal reasons prior to the camp session start date must be in writing to BLA&T@woodlandschool.org.**
- **Campers who leave during a session WILL NOT receive a credit. Camps are not prorated.**
- **We reserve the right to cancel a specialty camp date if participation numbers are not adequate. You may select an alternative specialty camp, or you may request a credit of tuition paid. Cancellations of sessions will occur a minimum one week prior to the session start date.**
